The San Francisco Bay Subtidal Habitat Goals Project is an interagency regional planning effort to advance the understanding and future management and restoration of submerged habitats in San Francisco Bay. A Draft Plan has been developed which includes conceptual models, maps, and current information about subtidal habitat types in the estuary. The Draft Plan also includes priority recommendations to improve research, restoration, and management of these habitats.

The San Francisco Bay Subtidal Habitat Goals Draft Plan will be released June 16th for a 45-day public review period. There will be two identical public meetings at which the interagency project team will present the Draft Plan and receive any initial public comment.
